Now your youngest users can successfully search your catalog. KCweb simplifies searches and results to encourage children to use library resources.

Web Content Chosen for Children

We develop each subject area in the KCweb PAC interface based on the age of the child and his or her curriculum needs. Children can access over 29,000 sites that focus on fun and education. Reading level graphics help children select a Web site at their level.

KCweb includes a "persistent environment" to keep young users within KCweb, even after they access selected Web sites.

We choose and monitor each Web site included with KCweb.

- **Content:** each Web site must have age-appropriate content
- **Useability:** sites must enable children to navigate to find information
- **Accuracy:** sites must be created by an authoritative source
- **Currency:** the site must be updated as often as needed
- **Reliability:** sites must not include bias or commercial interests
